#### 6. Our Future: Presentation by Nigel Crocker

Nigel gave a presentation on the transformation of the Benefice which we hope will move to becoming one church family and one parish. He recommended a holistic approach, of developing our strengths, being prepared to change and grow and reaching out to our communities. Nigel confirmed that he would be presenting to the other parishes in the Benefice at their APCMs later in the week and that the Diocese is in discussion with our Benefice over these proposals.

The PCC recorded their concern that the plans be communicated to the wider community with sensitivity and sympathy as they felt the need to engage them and give them ownership of the transformation. It was felt important that the change to One Church did not compromise the identity of each village. The PCC recorded their thanks to all those who had contributed to the PCC over the past year, particularly those stepping down from the PCC - Denise Hastie, Claire Pearson and Heather Tinsley and to the former churchwardens, Charles and Helen Fenn for all their work, especially during the past six months of change and transition.
